## Jr High Summer Application Guidelines

- Make sure your parents or guardians support your plan to go to a summer program.
   Discuss with your parents or guardian the details of the program you are considering.
   They need to be aware of safety, travel, and supervision issues before you apply. Make sure they agree that the program is appropriate for you.
- 2. Apply to the program you have chosen. Many programs begin accepting applications as early as January of the year you plan to attend. Make sure you are clear about their application deadlines. If you are accepted before the Education Foundation completes the selection process, include a copy of your acceptance with your application.
- 3. Fill out the Jr High Summer application. It includes questions about the program, why you chose it, and what you hope to learn. You can fill it out on line and then print it or print a blank copy of the form and fill it out by writing in the required information. Either way, the final step is to have your parents or gaurdiands review the form, then sign and date the bottom of the second page.
- 4. Turn in the application by the deadline as described in the instructions shown on this website on the page titled "Important Dates" in the section titled Jr High Summer.
